PROGRAM POLICIES

Students must earn a minimum GPA of 2.00 in the major, and the lowest acceptable grade is a "C" in all major and Stevenson Educational Experience (SEE) courses.

No student, regardless of major, will be permitted to advance to the next course without earning a grade of "C" or better in the prerequisite course(s). When a grade below a "C" is earned in a major course, the student must repeat that course.

A course may be repeated once without special permission. Criminal justice majors must apply in writing to the Dean of the School of Humanities and Social Sciences requesting permission to attempt a course for a third time.

COURSE INFORMATION

Specific pre- and co-requisites for each course are listed in the course descriptions.

All major required courses are offered each semester. CJUS Electives are offered on a rotational and as-needed basis.

GENERAL EDUCATION NOTES

General Education courses are identified in blue.

- Specific courses that fulfill SEE general education requirements are listed in the catalog and on the portal.
- Students must complete all general education and major requirements and earn a minimum of 120 credits.
- 15 credits must be taken at the 300 or 400 level.
- All courses in the student's last 30 credits must be taken at Stevenson.

*HUMANITIES classes must be from at least three different disciplines.

**SOCIAL SCIENCE classes must be from two different disciplines
