PROGRAM POLICIES

VCD student performance is measured by grades earned in general education and major courses and the ability to effectively create, compile, and present a portfolio of work. Portfolio reviews take place in each year of the program.

Students must earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and a minimum GPA of 3.0 in the major, and the lowest acceptable grade is a "C" in all required major courses. See also *Visual Communication Design Program Policies for Continuance & Progression in the University catalog.*

GENERAL EDUCATION NOTES

General Education courses are identified in blue.

- Specific courses that fulfill SEE general education requirements are listed in the catalog and on the portal.
- Students must complete all general education and major requirements and earn a minimum of 120 credits.
- 15 credits must be taken at the 300 or 400 level.
- All courses in the student's last 30 credits must be taken at Stevenson.

*HUMANITIES classes must be from at least three different disciplines.

**SOCIAL SCIENCE classes must be from two different disciplines.
